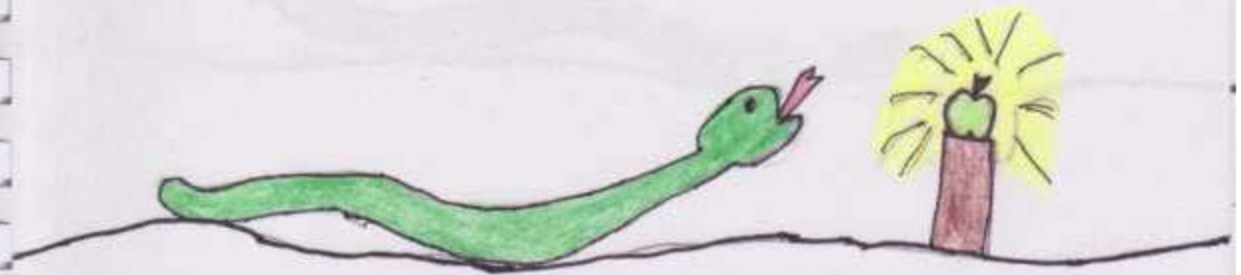
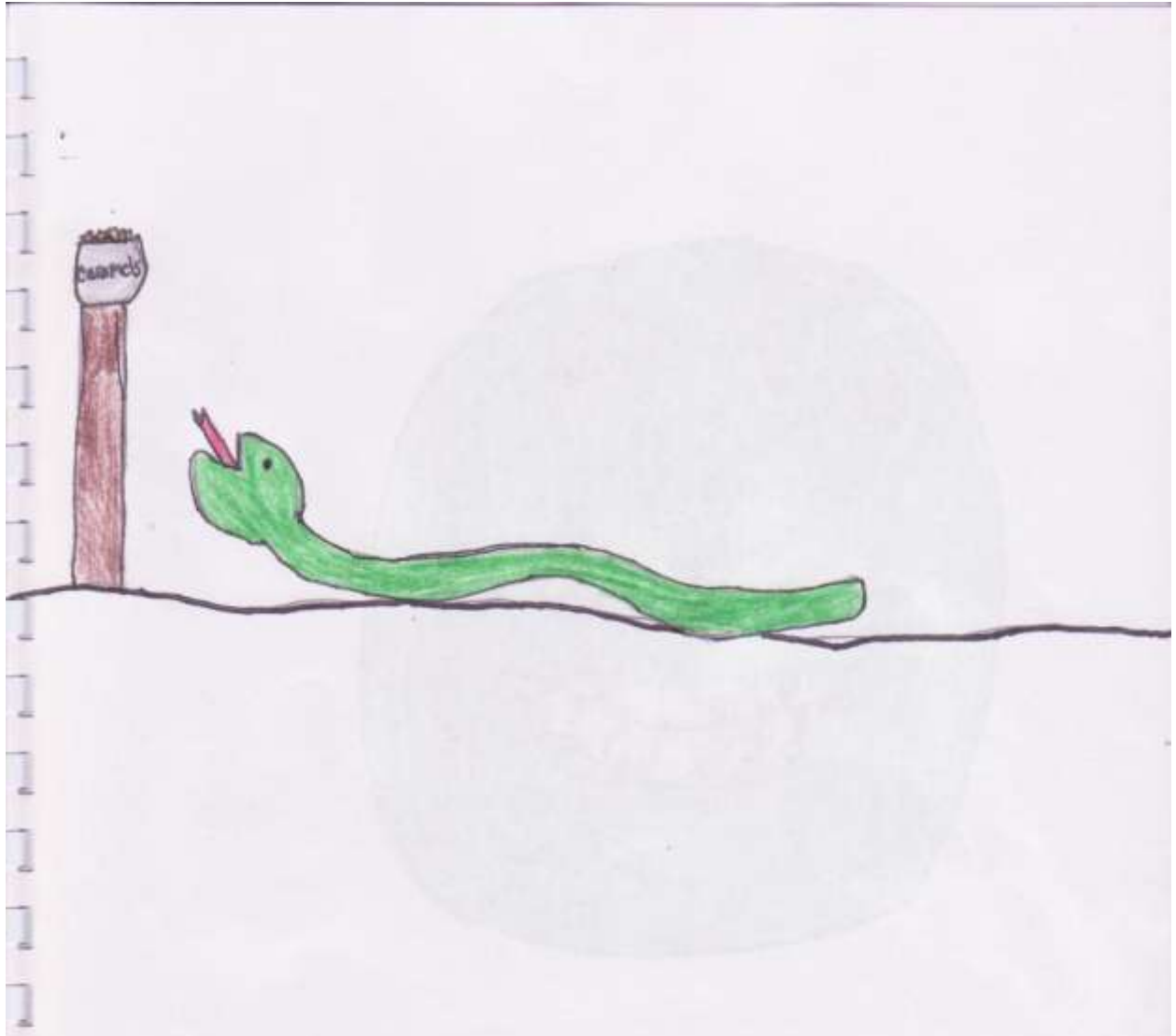


If You Give a Snake a Sour Apple

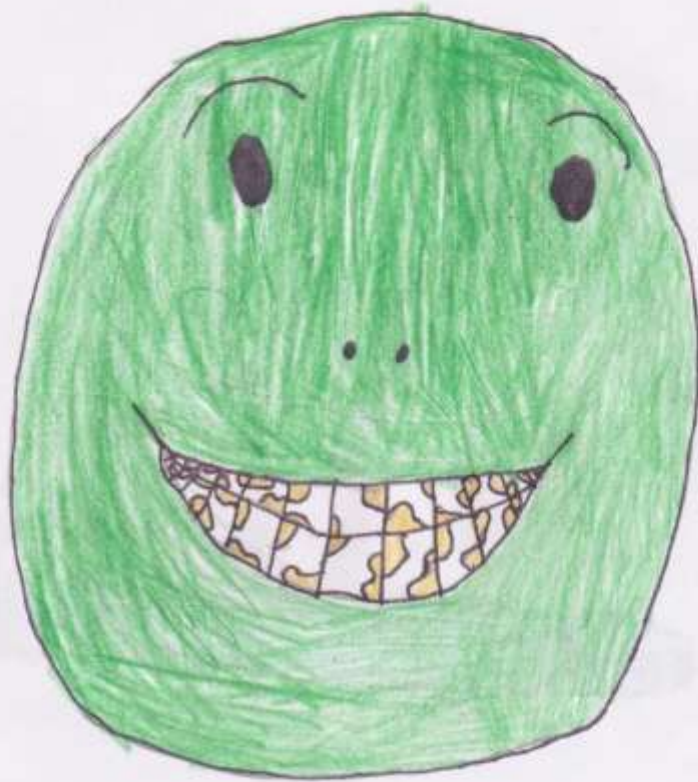

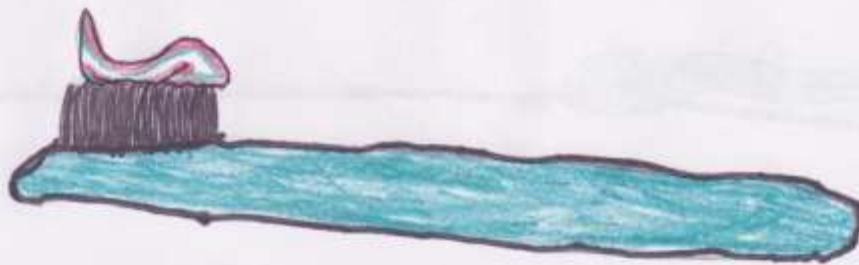


If you give a snake a sour apple...

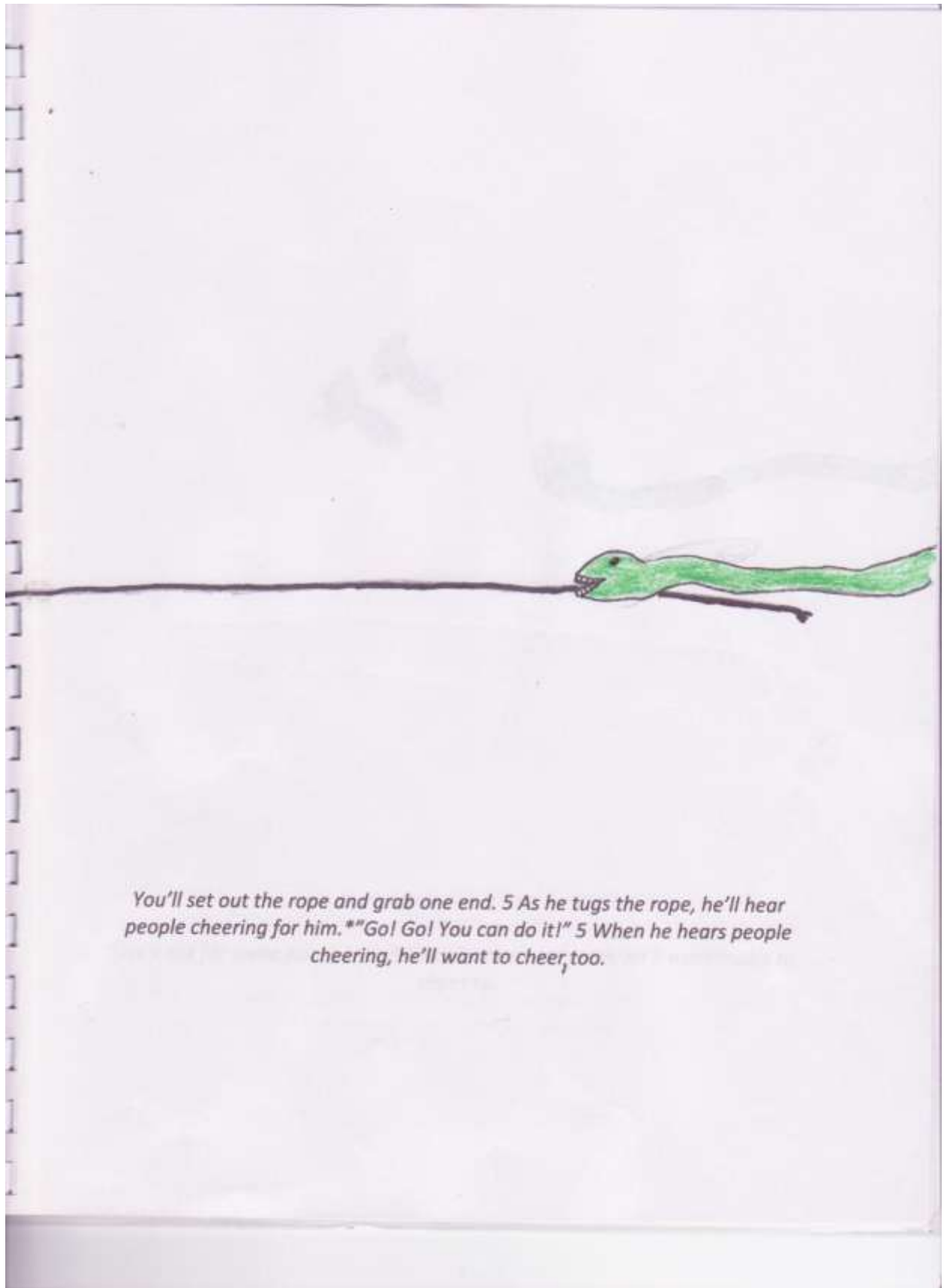
1 He's going to want a caramel to go with it.

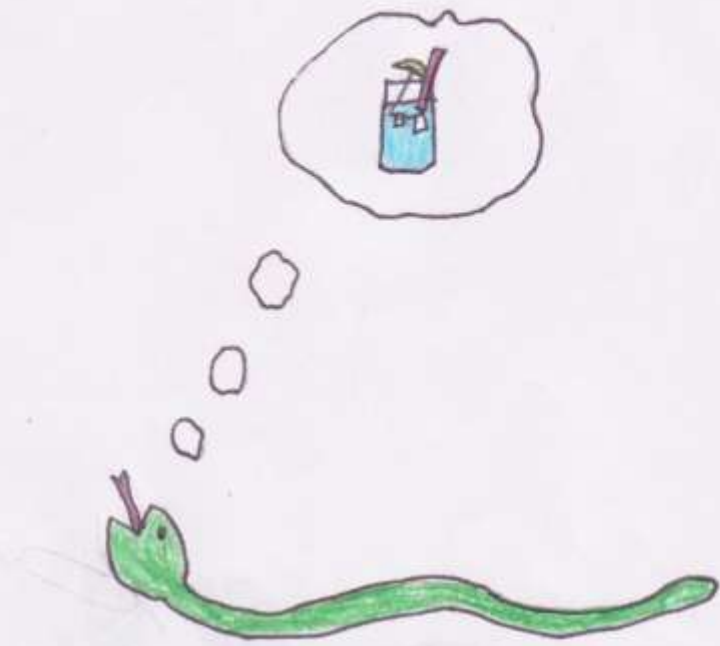


He'll ask for some pom poms. 5 Since he has pom poms, he'll want music to cheer to.

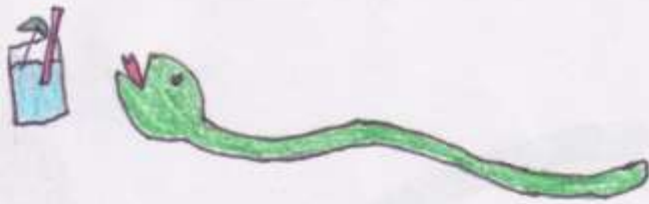
*2 In a hurry, you'll get pom poms, music, and then all the tubes. That will

2 In a hurry, you'll get him a music player and turn on the tunes. That will remind him that he enjoys dancing.



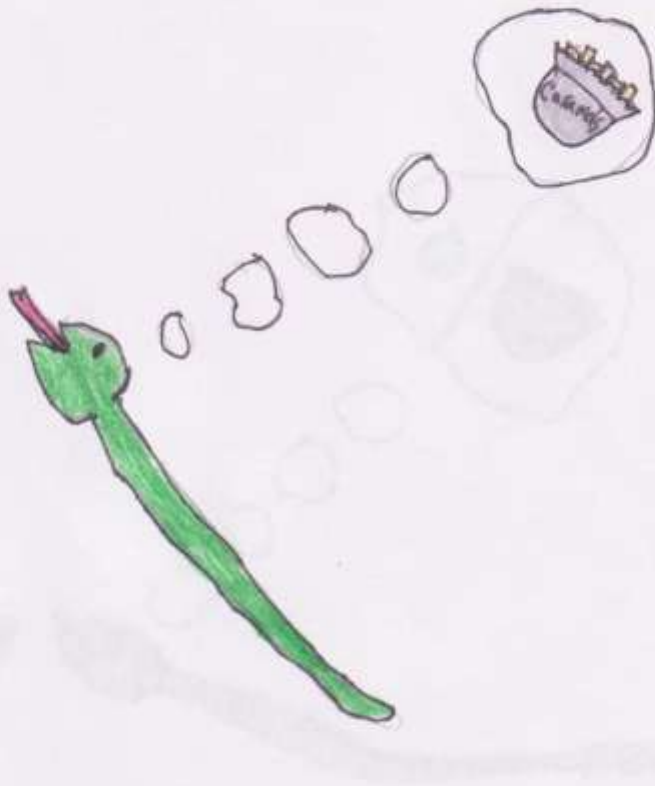
3 Gracefully, he'll dance until he gets tired. 5 If he gets tired, he'll want a glass of water.



*When you give him the water, he'll want to cool it down with some *cold, clear ice.*

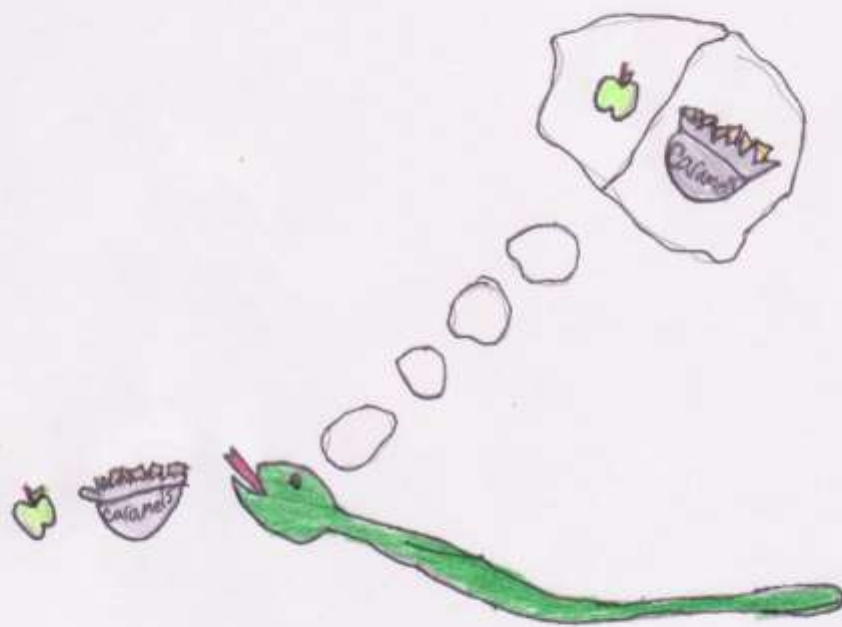


6 You'll head to the kitchen. 5 While you grab him ice, he will probably spy the caramel bag.
